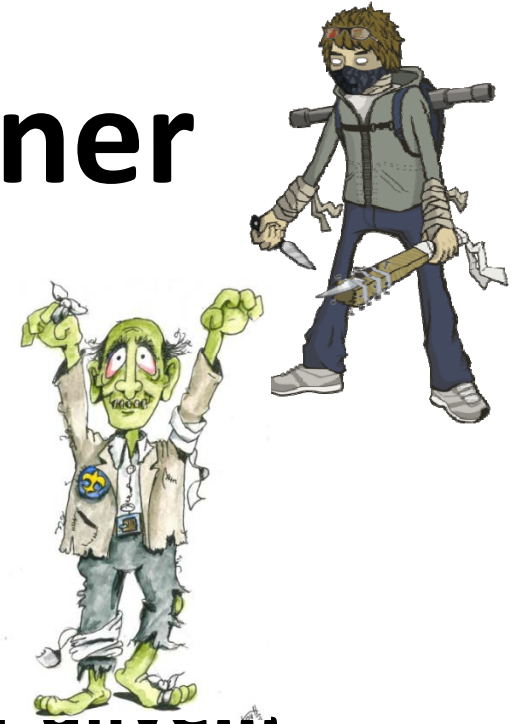


Merit Badge Madness
