  - Outdoor Skills for Webelos, Sat – Sun, May 3 - 4



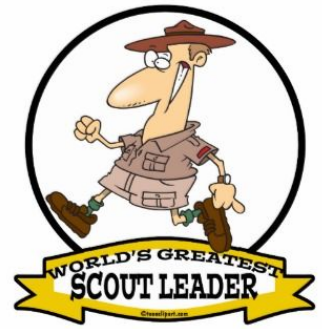
# Crow River Webelos Woods
